

Nuggets one win away from reaching NBA Finals

The Denver Nuggets beat the Los Angeles Lakers 119-108 in Game 3 of the Western Conference Finals. This gives the Nuggets a 3-0 lead in the series, and they are now close to clinching a spot in the NBA Finals.
